WHAT DO I DO NOW?

Carefully read the enclosed information so you understand your Offer of Admission and any conditions attached to it. If you have any questions about your offer, please contact the Admissions Office.

HOW DO I ACCEPT MY OFFER OF ADMISSION?

You accept your Offer of Admission by following the instructions printed on your offer prior to the expiry date.

HOW CAN I CHECK THE STATUS OF MY APPLICATION?

“My Nipissing” is a valuable online information system and we encourage you to regularly check WebAdvisor. Your admission status can be found under the Prospective Student menu. Information on how to access “My Nipissing” was included in the package you received acknowledging your application. We also recommend you regularly check your email.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN IF I HAVE A CONDITIONAL OFFER OF ADMISSION?

If you currently have courses in progress or have not graduated yet, your offer will be conditional upon successfully completing your courses and/or your diploma is awarded. As indicated on your Offer of Admission, you must request to have a final official transcript sent to us showing all courses are completed and/or your diploma has been awarded by August 15, 2025.

To remain eligible for admission into this program, you must meet the minimum requirements applicable for your pathway outlined in the chart below. **This is your Offer of Admission, and you should accept it by the deadline even if you have not yet met the conditions of your offer.**

Bachelor of Commerce (BCOMM) – College Partnership Program – Two Year Business Diploma Graduates*	<p>Algonquin College, Centennial College (Progress Campus), Lambton College, and St. Clair College graduates only.</p> <p>Minimum overall two-year Business diploma GPA of 72%. If your final average falls between 70% and 71.4% you will still meet the conditions of your offer of admission. However, your transfer credit will be reduced by 15 credits.</p>
Bachelor of Commerce (BCOMM) – College Partnership Program – Three Year Business Administration Diploma Graduates*	<p>Algonquin College, Centennial College (Progress Campus), Lambton College, and St. Clair College graduates only.</p> <p>Minimum overall three-year Business Administration diploma GPA of 72%. If your final average falls between 70% and 71.4% you will still meet the conditions of your offer of admission. However, your transfer credit will be reduced by 15 credits.</p>
Bachelor of Commerce (BCOMM) – College Partnership Program – Esports Entrepreneurship & Administration Graduates*	<p>Lambton College, and St. Clair College graduates only.</p> <p>Minimum overall Esports Entrepreneurship & Administration diploma GPA of 70%.</p>

*The Bachelor of Commerce – College Partnership Program only has two intakes per year: January and September.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DON'T MEET THE CONDITIONS OF MY OFFER OF ADMISSION?

If you do not meet the conditions of your offer by August 15, 2025, your Offer of Admission could be rescinded, or depending on your final overall GPA, we could change your program to the BComm Distance Learning program (this will also affect your transfer credit assessment). We will only rescind an offer if you are not eligible for admission once all courses and diploma are

completed. Please note that if you are repeating courses to raise your GPA, only the highest mark will be calculated in the final GPA. All courses, including repeated courses, must be completed by April 30, 2025, and you must graduate with the diploma required for your pathway (see chart above) no later than June 30, 2025.

WHEN WILL I RECEIVE MY TRANSFER CREDITS?

Nipissing University will assess your transcripts and determine your eligibility for transfer credit. If you are eligible for transfer credits, we will process them within 2 – 4 weeks after you have accepted our Offer of Admission AND we have received your final transcript showing you have graduated. If you received a conditional offer, you must request to have your institution send a final official transcript showing your courses are complete and/or your diploma has been awarded. This transcript request may be made through your OUAC account after you have graduated.

If you have been admitted to a second-degree program, a second-degree program plan will be designed by the Academic Advising Office and emailed to you.

Please note, you have been admitted to a 4-year program, however, should you choose to change to the 3-year program, please be advised that your transfer credit assessment will change. Program changes can be made after you have accepted your original Offer of Admission by emailing programchange@nipissingu.ca.

WHEN DO I REGISTER FOR MY COURSES?

In June, or after you accept your offer (for those who accept an offer after June), we will email you detailed information regarding registration. If you are receiving transfer credits, you may need to wait until your transfer credits are processed before registering for courses. You are encouraged to contact an Academic Advisor after your transfer credits have been processed to help you select your courses.

WHEN WILL I RECEIVE MY STUDENT EMAIL ACCOUNT?

You will receive your Nipissing email account approximately 3 days after your acceptance has been processed. We will notify you by email to the email account you indicated on your application to let you know that your Nipissing account is activated. From that point on, your Nipissing email account will be the only email account we will use to communicate with you. Make sure you check your email regularly to ensure you don't miss out on any important and urgent communication.
