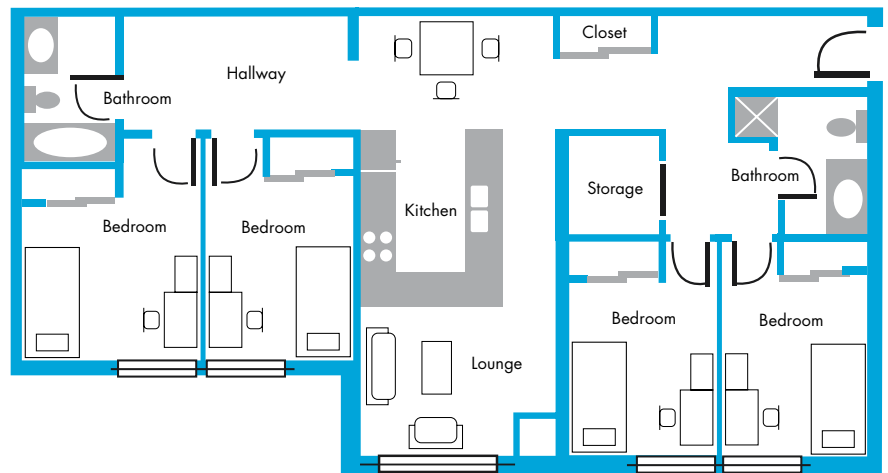

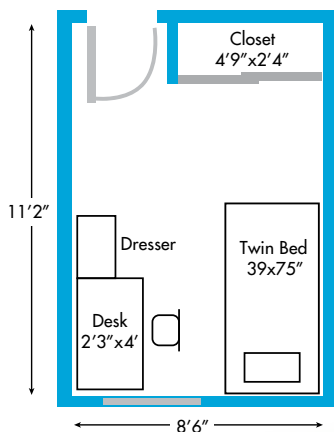

Important Dates

June 2, 2025 – To be considered for residence you must submit your application and pay your \$400 residence deposit.

Please note: BEEd students are placed in residence on a first-come, first-served basis, and the earlier you apply, the better chance you have of securing a spot.

August – Applicants will receive their residence assignment package from the Residence Admissions Office via email.

How to Apply to Residence

Residence applications are available through our online application for students who have received an offer of admission to the University. To access the residence application visit <https://nipissingu.erezlife.com/login>

1. Click on **'Activate Account'**
2. Enter your full name
3. Enter the email address that you entered on your OUAC application.
4. Enter the last 6 digits of your Nipissing Student number
5. A temporary password will be sent to your email address
6. Return to <https://nipissingu.erezlife.com/login> and enter your new password.
7. Once you are logged in, click on **Apply Now**
